



Know Your Soundbar



Charging the Soundbar

- . Fully charge the device before using the product for the first time.
- Connect the provided charging cable to the soundbar Type-C charging port and plug-in to a USB AC adapter.





Getting Started: Power ON / OFF

- Long Press @'POWER' Button for 3 secs to Power ON the Soundbar.
- Long Press @'POWER' Button for 3 secs to Power OFF the Soundbar



AUX

The soundbar includes AUX-IN port. Simply connect the soundbar and your music player with the provided 3.5mm AUX cable. Successful connection can be noted when the LED indicator flashes blue.



TF CARD

The soundbar has a TF card slot. It can support a memory card of up to 256 GB.



USB MODE

To enable USB Mode, plug in your pen drive to the USB port in the soundbar





Bluetooth Pairing

Bluetooth Pairing with Your Smartphone, Laptop or Smart TV for the First Time:



- Turn ON the soundhar
- . On the backside of the soundbar, a Blue LED light will flash, indicating Pairing Mode.
- In your device's Bluetooth menu, scan for new devices and select 'MadRabbit BOOM BAR'.
 The flashing Blue LED light will stabilize, indicating a successful connection.
- When the soundbar is in Pairing Mode, it will automatically connect to the last paired device. To connect to another device, disconnect from the last paired device.
- To disconnect the soundbar from the paired device, long press the (R) button for 1.5 secs.

Auto OFF

When the soundbar is turned on and there is no connection or operation for 10 mins, it will automatically turn off.

LED INDICATOR

- Blue LED light flashes: Waiting for connection
- Blue LED light stabilizes: Successful Bluetooth connection
- Blue LED light flashes: AUX-IN connection
- · Red LED light stabilizes: Charging
- · Red LED light turns off: Charging Completed

	Anti-clockwise Rotation	Turn Down the Volume.

TWS (Twin Speaker Pairing)



Pairing:

- Turn on both soundbars and keep them close
- Make sure they are not connected to any other Bluetooth devices.
- Long press the play / pause button on any one soundbar until you hear a sound.
- After that, you will hear another sound on both soundbars, indicating the soundbars are paired.
- 5. Now, you can simply connect your device to the soundbar and enjoy the TWS mode.

Unpairing:

- 1. Long press @play / pause button on any one of the connected soundbars.
- 2. You will hear a sound, indicating the soundbars are unpaired from TWS mode.

(FOR TWS MODE, YOU WILL NEED TO PURCHASE ANOTHER SOUNDBAR)

Safety Information

Electronic Devices

Do not use this device in the place where wireless devices are prohibited, otherwise it will
interfere with other electronic devices or cause other dangers.

Operating Environment

- Do not use the device in dusty, sharp, compact areas or near magnetic fields, etc., to avoid failure of the internal circuit of the device.
- · Preferably use the product in a typical indoor environment.
- When installing the device, please keep away from strong magnetic fields or electrical
 appliances with strong magnetic fields, such as ovens and refrigerators.
- Do not use the device in thunderstorm weather. It may cause equipment failure or electric shock hazard.



Safety Information

- Please use the device within a temperature range of -10 °C ~ +55 °C, and store the device and its accessories within a temperature range of -40 °C ~ +70 °C. When the ambient temperature is too high or too low, it may lead to device malfunction. When the temperature is below 5 °C. the performance of the battery is limited.
- . Do not place the device in direct sunlight, such as the dashboard or window sill of a car.
