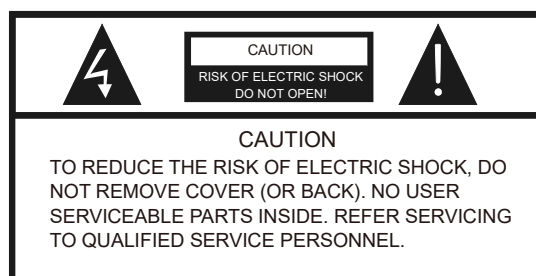


# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

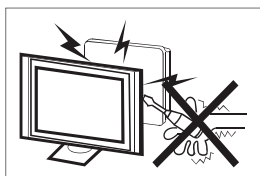

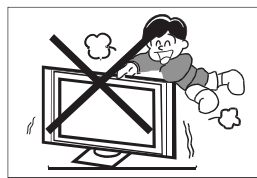

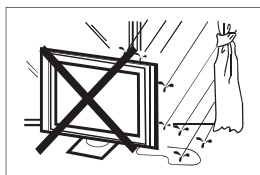
## PRECAUTIONS AND REMINDERS



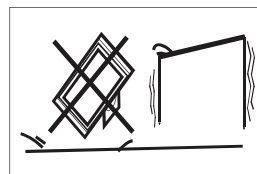
High voltages are used in the operation of this television receiver. Do not remove the cabinet back from your set. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.



Never stand on, lean on, or suddenly push the television or its stand. You should pay special attention to children. Serious injury may result if it falls.



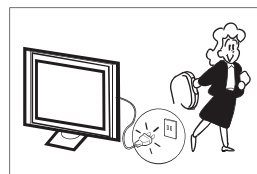
To prevent fire or electrical shock hazard, do not expose the television receiver to rain or moisture.



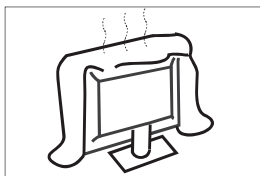
Do not place your television on an unstable cart, stand, shelf or table. Serious injury to an individual, and damage to the television, may result if it falls.



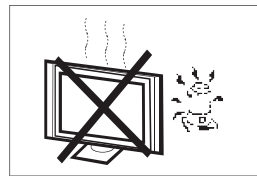

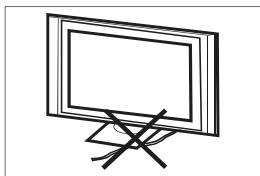
When the television receiver is not used for an extended period of time, it is advisable to disconnect the AC power cord from the AC outlet.



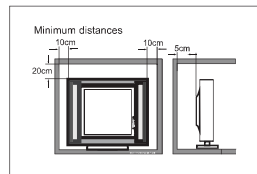

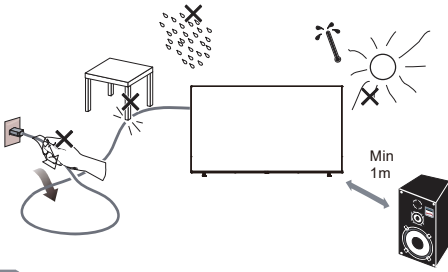

## PREPARATION AND CONTROLS

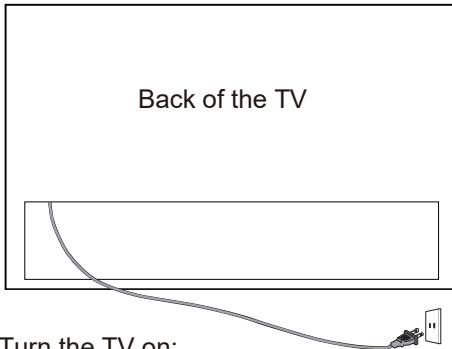
### TURNING ON THE TV

1. Install the stand and place the TV on a solid surface.



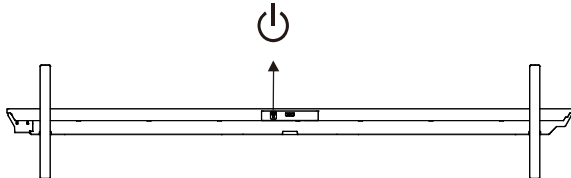
#### NOTE

2. Connect the antenna or cable to the **ANT** aerial socket on the back of the TV set.
  3. Power:  
Plug the cord into a working power outlet.



4. Turn the TV on:  
Press **⏻** on the remote control or **POWER** button at the bottom/side of the TV.

## INITIAL SETUP

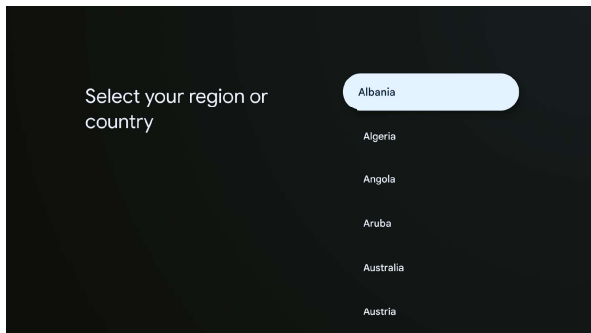
The first time you turn on your TV, the setup wizard will guide you through setting up basic settings. Please according to the Text Tip to First Time Setup.



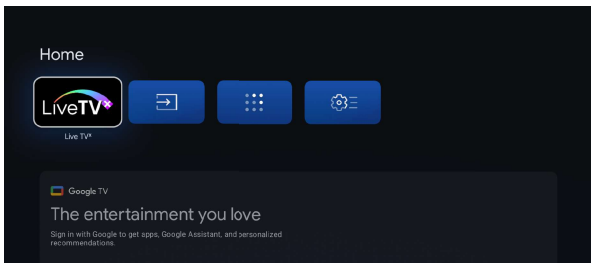
This function is used for the remote control pair code. After the code is successful, you can use the Bluetooth remote control to operate the TV.



Press **▲/▼** to select the system language and press **OK** to confirm the language.

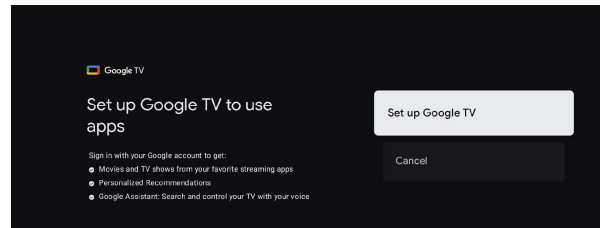


Press **▲/▼** to select the region/country of your device and press **OK** to confirm. Complete the TV initialization settings according to the guide prompt.

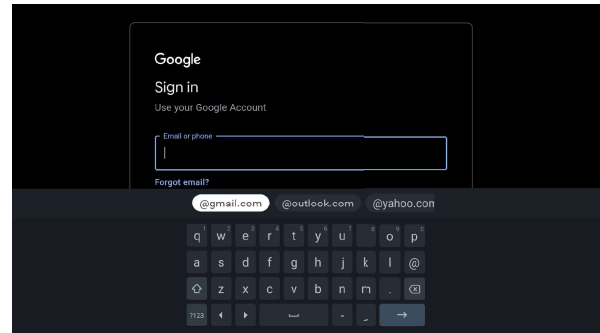

Press **▲/▼** to select the "Set up Google TV" of your device and press **OK** to complete the setup.

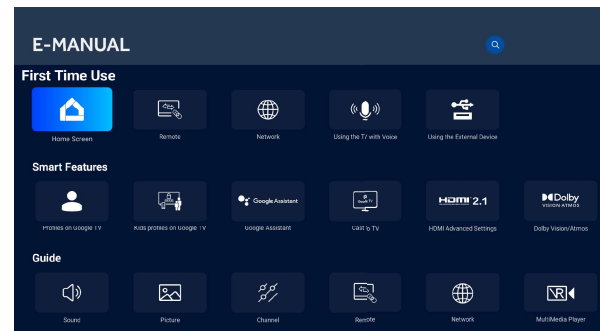


Use your Google Account Sign in. Follow the Google Guide.
