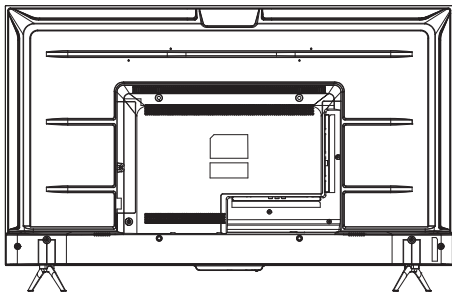
PREPARING YOUR LED TV FOR WALL MOUNTING

We suggest that you keep your TV at least 2.36 inches (60 mm) from the wall to prevent cable interference. Before mounting your TV on the wall, you need to remove the stand.

For your safety, please use only with a UL listed wall mount bracket with minimum weight of the TV without stand.

To attach a wall mount bracket to your TV:

1. Remove the screws holding your TV to the stand.
2. Remove the stand from your TV.
3. Secure the wall mount bracket to the back of your TV using four screws. Follow the instructions of the user manual that came with the wall mount bracket to install.



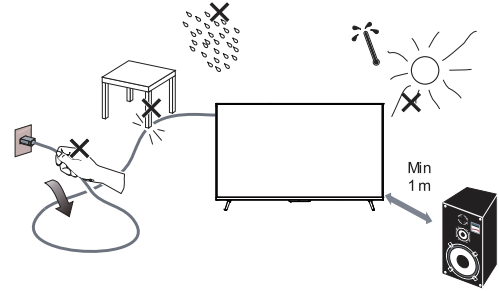

"Ghost" or double image	• This may be caused by obstruction to the antenna due to high rise buildings or hills. Using a highly directional antenna may improve the picture.
No power	• Check if the TV's AC power cord is plugged into the outlet. • Unplug the TV, wait for 60 seconds. Then reinsert plug into the outlet and turn on the TV again.
