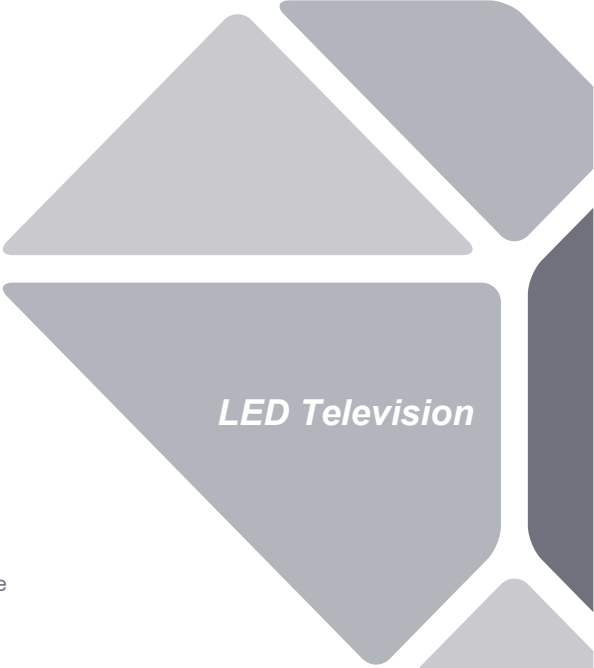

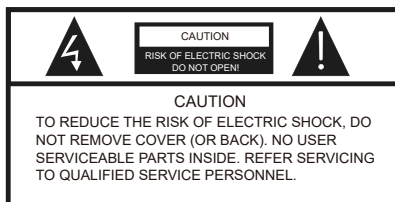
- 1) Read these instructions.

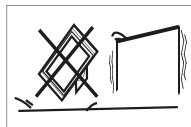
High voltages are used in the operation of this television receiver. Do not remove the cabinet back from your set. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.



Never stand on, lean on, or suddenly push the television or its stand. You should pay special attention to children. Serious injury may result if it falls.



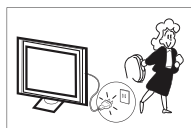
To prevent fire or electrical shock hazard, do not expose the television receiver to rain or moisture.



Do not place your television on an unstable cart, stand, shelf or table. Serious injury to an individual, and damage to the television, may result if it falls.



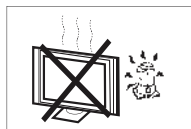
Do not drop or push objects into the television cabinet slots or openings. Never spill any kind of liquid on the television receiver.



When the television receiver is not used for an extended period of time, it is advisable to disconnect the AC power cord from the AC outlet.



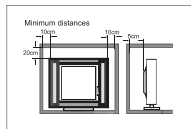
Do not block the ventilation holes in the back cover. Adequate ventilation is essential to prevent failure of electrical components.

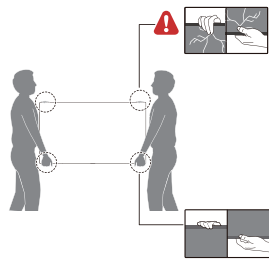
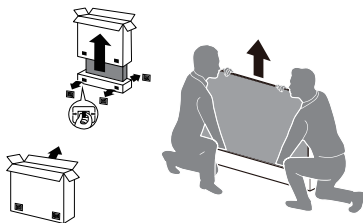

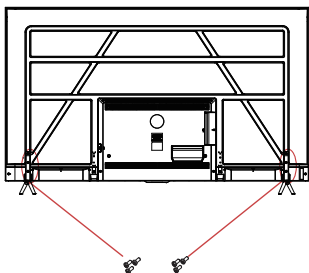
PREPARATION

IMPORTANT: Do not apply pressure to the screen display area which may compromise the integrity of the display. The manufacturer's warranty does not cover user abuse or improper installations.

ATTACHING THE STAND

IMPORTANT: The stand of the TV must be assembled prior to usage.

1. Place the TV unit face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc.) to prevent any damage to the TV.
2. Fix the stand to the bottom of the TV with the 6 screws.



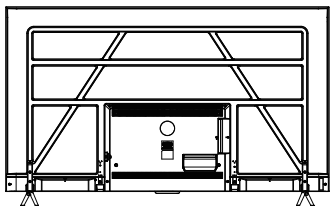
PREPARING YOUR OLED TV FOR WALL MOUNTING

We suggest that you keep your TV at least 2.36 inches (60 mm) from the wall to prevent cable interference. Before mounting your TV on the wall, you need to remove the standand.

For your safety, please use only with a UL listed wall mount bracket with minimum weight of the TV without stand.

To attach a wall mount bracket to your TV:

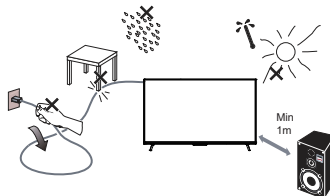
1. Remove the screws holding your TV to the stand.
2. Remove the stand from your TV.
3. Secure the wal mount bracket to the back of your TV using four screws. Follow the instructions of the user manual that came with the wall mount bracket to install.



4. Fix the wall mount screws (M8x20mm/4pcs) into the rear side of the LED TV, using the torque of 8kgf,cm.

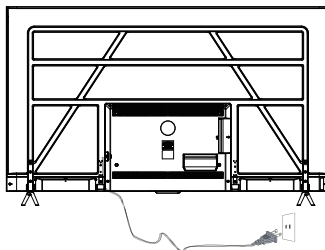
TURNING ON THE TV

1. Install the stand and place the TV on a solid surface.



NOTE

- Ensure that the TV is placed in a position to allow free flow of air. Do not cover the ventilation openings on the back cover.
 - To prevent any unsafe situations, no naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on or in the vicinity.
 - Avoid heat, direct sunlight and exposure to rain or water. The equipment shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing.
2. Connect the antenna cable or cable TV cable to the **ANT** in aerial socket on the back of the TV set.
 3. Power:
Plug the cord into a working power outlet.



4. Turn the TV on:
Press **⏻** on the remote control or **POWER** button on the side control pannel of the TV.

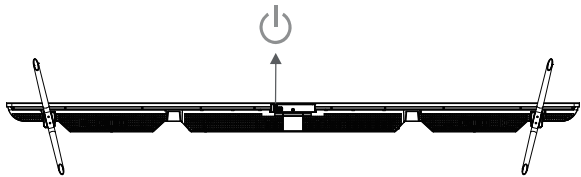

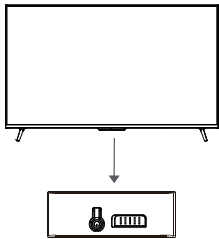
PERIPHERAL CONTROLS

HANDS FREE VOICE CONTROL



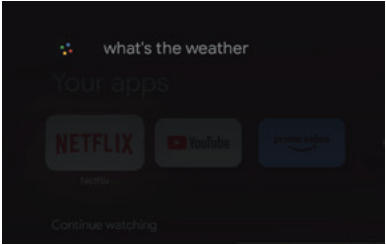
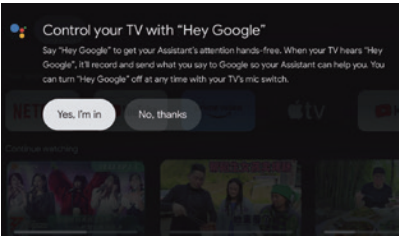
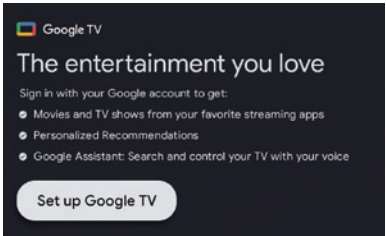

HOW TO USE HANDS FREE VOICE CONTROL :

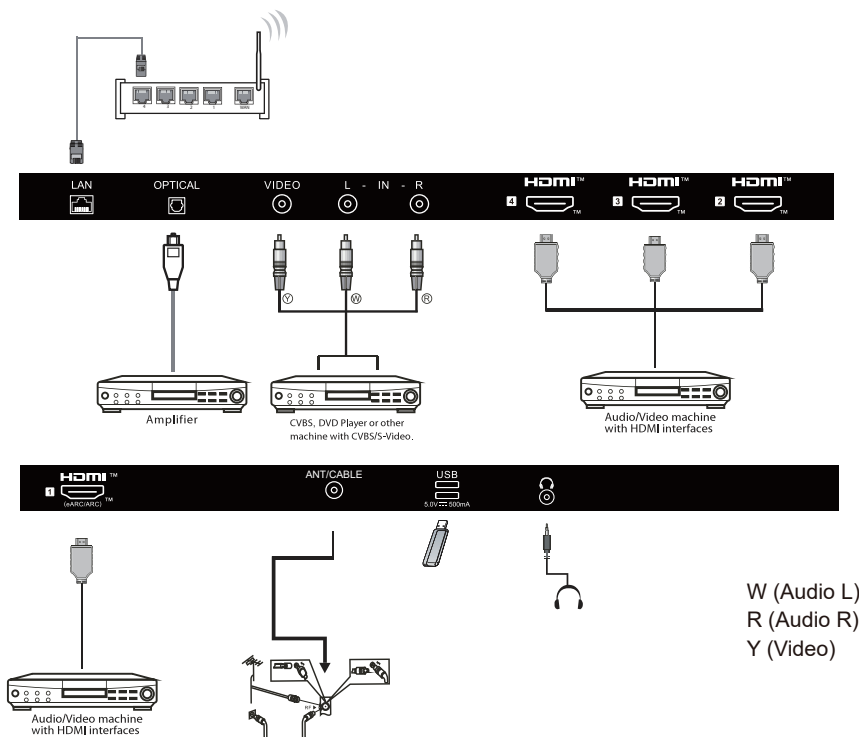
1. Activate the hands free voice control with the toggle switch.
2. Select "Set up Google TV" on home screen to open the Google assistant settings, and select sign in.



3. When the prompt "Control your TV with Hey Google! " is prompted, select "Yes I'm in", it can be used. For example, when we say "Hey Google,What's the weather", hands free voice indicator will light up and feed back the weather conditions.

TERMINAL CONNECTION

You can use the input terminals on TV set rear as follows.



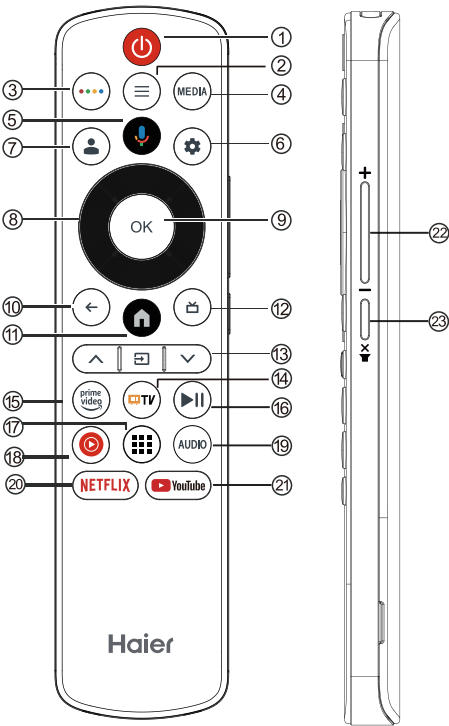
Note :

1. Using a non-certified HDMI cable may result a blank screen or a connection error.
2. Some HDMI cables and devices may not be compatible with the TV due to different HDMI specifications.
3. Do not connect Headphone out to Home Theatre Line in / Aux in / Audio In.
4. We recommend to use a USB drive with 1GB free space and a disk speed faster than 5.0MB/sec
5. USB port supports a voltage of 5V & maximum current consumption of 500mA.
6. Depending on the file, playback may not be possible, even when using the supported formats.
7. When connecting an audio system which is not compatible with ARC, you need to connect an optical audio cable to "OPTICAL" output.

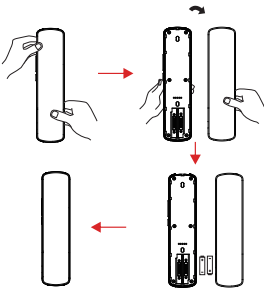

Insert the 2 supplied batteries (Type AAA 1.5V).

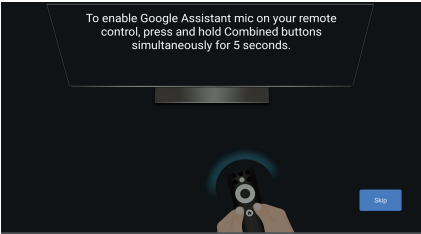


#	Item	Descriptions
1	Power	Press to turn the TV on or off. When your TV is off, power still flows through it. To completely disconnect power, unplug the power cord.
2		Press to open or close the on-screen menu.
3		Press to open Soft Keyboard.
4	MEDIA	Press to open the Media Center.
5		Press to enter start a voice search.
6		Press to open the Dashboard.
7		Switch Google accounts in Google TV mode.
8		Press to navigate the on-screen menu.
9	OK	Enter the selected option or perform the selected operation.
10		Return to the previous menu.
11		Press to open the Home Page.

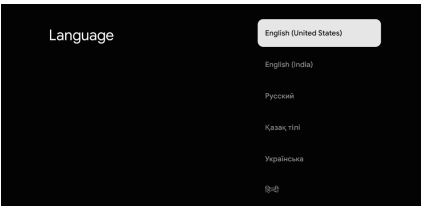

INITIAL SETUP

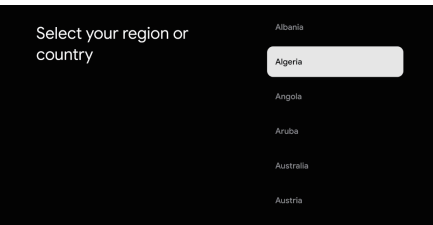
The first time you turn on your TV, the setup wizard will guide you through setting up basic settings. Please according to the Text Tip to First Time Setup.



This function is used for the remote control pair code. After the code is successful, you can use the Bluetooth remote control to operate the TV.

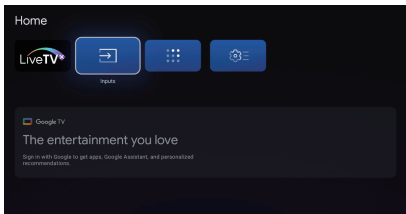


Press ▲/▼ to select the system language and press **OK** to confirm the language.



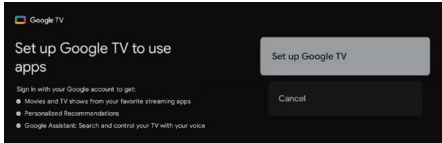
Press ▲/▼ to select the region/country of your device and press **OK** to confirm.

Complete the TV initialization settings. according to the guide prompt.



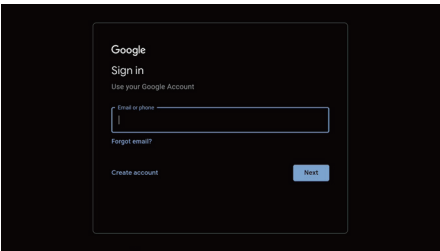

Press ▲/▼ to select the “Set up Google TV” of your device and press **OK** to complete the setup.

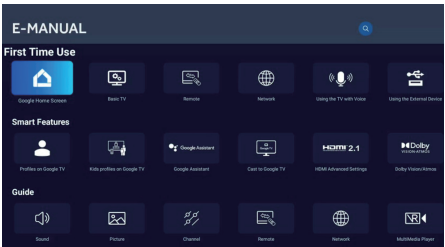
